



1. Is this the first time reading these guidelines?




Are these guidelines clear and do they make sense?




3. How satisfied are you with the current rules on parking?



4. How would you rate the level of severity of the community parking rules?




5. Is there anything that you would like to see changed in the current guidelines? (32 Total Responses)
