	<p>Aloe Vera (Asparagaceae) Size: varies Sun: Full sun Color: varies Disease: fertilize spring and summer Disease: Root rot from overwatering. Water: Limited watering with full drying between.</p>
	<p>Arizona Rosewood (Vauquelinia Californica) Size: 8x8' slow growing Sun: Full to partial sun Small white flowers in umbels followed by ugly, small brown fruit. Care: Prune, do not shear. Disease: Prone to root rot. Can be trained to a small vase-shaped "tree." Water: deep irrigation monthly during summer only Drought/Heat: Tolerant to hot weather < 110F.</p>






	<p>Arizona Yellow Bells (Tecoma stans) Size: 8x8 ' Sun: Full to partial shade Care: Prune if frost or sun damaged only Water: deep irrigation as needed during summer Drought/Heat: Tolerant to 110F. Note: If it gets straggly prune to 6" stub in early spring and fertilize</p>
	<p>Autumn Sage (Salvia greggii) Size: 3x3 ' Sun: Full to partial shade Disease: susceptible to spittle bug - prune and remove infected stems Care: Prune mid-summer and late winter - not shear Water: deep irrigation as needed during summer</p>
	<p>Baja Fairy Duster (Calliandra californica) Size: 5x5 ' Sun: Full sun Care: Prune during fall or early spring to keep shape but do not shear. Water: Low water once established</p>
	<p>Baja or Desert Ruellia (Ruellia peninsularis) Size: 4x5 ' Sun: full sun to filtered shade Care: Prune do not shear Water: low water once established</p>





	<p>Black Dalea (Dalea Frutescens) Size: 3x5' Sun: Full Water: Medium water Care: cleanup around bottom occasionally Note: Healthiest when grown as ground cover, not shrub. Shear severely in winter or early spring.</p>
 	<p>Bougainvillea (Bougainvillea brasiliensis or glabra) Size: varies based on pruning and use of Trellises Sun: Full to partial shade Water: Lots of green, but little color = too much H2O. Care: PUNE as needed for desired shape. Fertilize regularly Sept-Nov and Mar-May Drought/Heat: Tolerant</p> <p>Disease: None, but becomes unhealthy if not watered and fertilized correctly.</p> <p>The bottom image will look like the top image if sheared.</p>
	<p>Bottle Brush (Callistemon viminalis) Size: 3x5' Sun: Full Care: Prune but no shears Water: Keep moist, but not wet. Drought/Heat: Resistant</p>
	<p>Candelilla (Euphorbia antisiphilitica) Size: 3x2' Sun: Full sun Water: during hot/dry summer Drought/Heat: Desert love Care: Cutback to ground in late Winter. Flowers: Tiny orchid like down full stem. Note: Wax on stems used for candles</p>






	<p>Cape Honeysuckle (<i>Tecomaria capensis</i>) Size: 8x6 Sun: Full to partial shade Water: deep irrigation during summer Drought/Heat: Tolerant Care: Prune; cut back to 6" every 3-4 years to reduce sprawling.</p>
	<p>Chaparral Sage (<i>Salvia clevelandii</i>) Size: 4x6' Sun: Full or partial sun. Low water. Water: low Drought/Heat: Tolerant Care: Spring pruning to remove spent flowering stalks - do not shear.</p>
	<p>Chichuahuan Sage (<i>Leucophyllum laevigatum</i>) Size: 5x6' Sun: Full sun Water: low Drought/Heat: Tolerant Care: Prune only to encourage dense habit.</p>
	<p>Chuparosa (<i>Justica californica</i>) Size: 6x12' Sun: Full sun for flowers Water: Low Drought/Heat: Tolerant Care: Prune in spring but never shear.</p>
	<p>Common Myrtle (<i>Myrtus communis</i>) Size: 12x6' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: Needs moist, well-drained soil Drought/Heat: Sensitive Care: Shearing cleanly to give shape or let it grow naturally Note: Used to produce Mirto in Sardinia</p>




	<p>Compact Myrtle (<i>Myrtus communis compacta</i> or Dwarf) Size: 2x3' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: Low water Care: Prune to remove dead, broken or diseased branches. Shearing up to 1/3 for shaping. Disease: Overwatering = root rot or fungal diseases.</p>
	<p>Deer Grass (<i>Muhlenbergia regens</i>) Size: 3x4' Sun: Full sun Water: low water weekly. Care: Cutback in fall to 6"</p>
	<p>Desert Lavender (<i>Condea emoryi</i>) Size: 1x2' Sun: Full to partial shade Water: low Care: Prune individual stems in Summer Note: Semi-Deciduous</p>
	<p>Desert Spoon (<i>Dasylirion wheeleri</i>) Size: 4x4' Sun: Full sun Water: Low Care: No pruning to shape but remove any dead leaves.</p>
	<p>Elephant Food (<i>Portulacaria Afra</i>) Size: up to 12'x6' Sun: Full to partial Water: low to occasional Care: Easily recovers from heavy pruning. Can be left unpruned as a ground cover or manicured in to shapes</p>

 <p>g</p>	<p>Emu Bush (<i>Eremphila maculata</i>) Size: 5x5' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: low Care: Prune individual stems or light shearing after Spring flowering Drought/Heat: tolerant once established Note: Short-lived plant. Red to pink flowers. Attracts hummingbirds.</p>
	<p>Feathery Cassia (<i>Cassia artemisioides</i>) Size: 5x5' Sun: Full sun Water: Low Care: Can be sheared but prefers light pruning late fall Drought/Heat: Tolerant</p>
	<p>Giant Hesperaloe (<i>Hesperaloe funifera</i>) Size: 6x6' Sun: Full sun Water: Minimal water. Care: Prune dead steps near base Drought/Heat: Tolerant Note: Nocturnal flowers pollinated by bats and hummingbirds.</p>
	<p>Gold Coin (<i>Asteriscus maritimus</i>) Size: 1x4 Sun: Full sun Water: Low to Medium water Care: No pruning. Cleanup any dead stems in late fall. Drought/Heat: Somewhat Tolerant</p>
	<p>Grass Tree (<i>Dasylirion longissimum</i>) Size: 10x6' Sun: Full sun Water: Dry - limited water Care: Clear dead leaves from bottom in late fall Drought/Heat: Tolerant</p>



	<p>Green Cloud Sage (Leucophyllum Frutescens) Size: 8x6' Sun: Full sun Water: regularly until established, then deep soak weekly Care: Prune at end of Winter before new growth appears Drought/Heat: Tolerant</p>
	<p>Heavenly Bamboo (Nandina Domestica) Size: 8x4' Sun: Full to partial sun. Water: Keep moist Care: Prune in Spring to retain small habit and removal of old branches and weak growth at ground level. Drought/Heat: Somewhat Tolerant</p>
	<p>Hardy Hibiscus ((Hibiscus moscheutos) Size: 3x5' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: every other day during Summer, then once every other week during Winter. Care: Prune to ground in Spring as new shoots emerge. Drought/Heat: Tolerant</p>
	<p>Hop Bush (Dodonaea viscosa) Size: 15x15' Sun: Full to partial Water: low to moderate. Care: Minimal pruning to shape - no shearing. Drought/Heat: Tolerant Note: Great for home beer makers</p>
	<p>Katie Ruellia (Ruellia brittoniana - Katie) Size: 1.5x2' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: Low Drought/Heat: tolerant with moderate watering in summer.</p>



	<p>Lantana (all species) Size: 4x6' Sun: Full to partial shade. Water: regularly and deeply during first year, then deep water 1/week. Care: Prune back significantly in spring to improve growth and shape. Note: healthiest when kept to a low habit of 2x3'</p>
	<p>Mexican and Red Bird of Paradise (Caesalpinia Mexicana and pulcherrima "Peacock flower") Size: 10x8' Sun: Full sun Water: Weekly Care: Cut stems back to the ground in later winter Drought/Heat: Tolerant</p> <p>Image 1: Mexican Bird of Paradise often shaped into small tree Image 2: Red Bird of Paradise often left as small shrub</p>
	<p>Mexican Honeysuckle or Firecracker Plant (Justicia spicigera) Size: 8x5' Sun: Full sun to partial shade, avoid western summer sun Water: moderate and deep Care: Prune to retain desired shape for no shearing. Drought/Heat: Tolerant; leaves burn Note: Attracts White flies. Fertilize in late winter.</p>
	<p>Natal Plum "Green Carpet" (Apocynaceae Carissa macrocarpa) Size: 8x5 Sun: Full to partial shade. Drought/Heat: Tolerant Water: Medium Care: Prune only to maintain shape. Fertilize young plants in spring and summer. Notes: Red fruit makes a tasty jam. All other</p>





	<p>parts are extremely poisonous to dogs.</p> <p>Penstemon "Beardtongues" (Plantaginaceae Lamiales) Size: 3x3' Sun: Full sun Water: Low Care: Cut spent flower spikes. In late fall, cut back to 4-6" from ground Note: Over 250 varieties</p>
	<p>Oleander (Nerium) Size: 6x5' Sun: Full sun Water: Low except during drought when deep watering weekly is needed. Care: Prune early spring and summer Note: Contact with foliage and flowers can cause skin irritations and allergic reactions.</p>
	<p>Red Yucca (Hesperaloe parviflora) Size: 5x2' Sun: Full sun Water: Low Drought/Heat: Tolerant Note: Hummingbird attraction</p>
	<p>Rosemary (Rosmarinus lamiaceae) Size: 2x5' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: Regular watering Care: Prune to retain growth boundary Drought/Heat: Tolerant</p>
	<p>Silver Leaf Cassia (Cassia artemesoides) Size: 6x6' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: Weekly deeply Care: Prune or shear to keep shape Note: Has large seed pods. Water weekly deep. Too much water can cause root rot.</p>





	<p>Sweet Broom (<i>Cytisus spachianus</i>) Size: 8x6' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: Likes well drained but moist soil. Care: Prune for shape.</p>
	<p>Tree Mallow (<i>Lavatera maritima</i>) Size: 8x6 mound Sun: Full sun Water: Occasional Drought/Heat: tolerant. Care: Fertilize early spring. Prune early spring or late winter.</p>
	<p>Totem Pole (<i>Lophocereus schottii monstrosus</i>) Size: 10x10' Sun: Full sun, reflective heat Water: Low water, well drained Care: Watch base for rot from too much water</p>

	<p>Arizona Velvet Mesquite (<i>Prosopis velutina</i>) Size: 25x35' Sun: Full sun, reflective heat Water: Deep water every 10 days first year, then only in drought conditions. Care: Prune in fall or early winter. Notes: Thorns. Massive root system. Will crack large concrete if not planted deep in soil.</p>
	<p>Chaste tree (<i>Vitex agnus-castus</i>) Size: 20x20' Sun: Full sun Water: Low to moderate watering, except deep watering during drought. Drought/Heat: Resistant Care: Prune late Winter before new growth</p>





	<p>Desert Fern (<i>Lysiloma microphylla</i>) Size: 20x20' Sun: Full sun to partial shade Water: low, except deep watering during drought Drought/Heat: Resistant Note: "Giant shrub on steroids" must be trained to a multi-trunk tree. Messy with fruit pods, flowers and leaves drop.</p>
	<p>Desert Ironwood (<i>Olneya tesota</i>) Size: 25x15' Sun: Full sun Water: Low to zero Care: Prune lower branches to show multi-trunk. Drought/Heat: Exceptionally Tolerant Note: Usually grow as small, sparse trees. Pea-like flowers from April to June.</p>
	<p>Desert Sweet acacia (<i>Acacia smallii</i>) Size: 25x20' Sun: Full sun Water: Low water after first year. Care: Drought/Heat: Extremely Tolerant Notes: Lots of yellow flower-balls and seed pods. Aggressive root system with thick roots running well beyond canopy.</p>
	<p>Desert Willow (<i>Chilopsis linearis</i>) Size: 20x20' Sun: Full sun or part shade Water: Deep water weekly for first year, then every 2-3 weeks in summer and monthly in winter. Care: Prune in spring by removing lowest limbs until tree height is reached. Drought/Heat: Tolerant Notes: Root system with long tap root that anchors tree.</p>

	<p>Leather Leaf Acacia (Acacia craspedocarpia) Size: 12x15' Sun: Full sun Water: Low but multiple drips at varying ranges needed to promote healthy roots Care: Prune lower branches to form canopy Drought/Heat: Tolerant Notes: Yellow rod-shaped flowers</p>
	<p>Mastic Tree (Pistacia lentiscus "Arabic gum") Size: 25x20' Sun: Full sun Water: Occasional deep watering. Care: Prune lower branches to elevate the base of the canopy and make multi-stems. Drought/Heat: Tolerant Notes: Ancient Greece used to form remedy for snakebite; Persia used gum to fill dental cavities.</p>
	<p>Mulga (Acacia eneura; "Dream Seed") Size 20x12' Sun: Full sun Water: Regular-deep to increase growth rate. Care: Prune lower branches to elevate the base of the canopy. Drought/Heat: Tolerant Notes: Broadleaf evergreen with needle-like, silvery-gray foliage. Dark red branches become darker brown at maturity. Produces golden yell, puffy blooms that appear 2-4 times a year.</p>
	<p>Mexican Fan Palm (Washingtonia robusta) Size: up to 100x15' Sun: Full sun. Water: Keep damp for @ 3 months, then water sparingly during Summer. Care: Remove dead frons; annual feeding. Drought/Heat: Resistant Notes: Do not plant near buildings. Susceptible to rot from over watering. Prune dead fronds.</p>

	<p>Palo Blanco/Mariosousa (Acacia) willardiana Size: 15x20' Sun: Full sun a must. Water: Little to no water, except during drought/dry spells. Drought/Heat: Tolerant. Notes: Semi-evergreen woody perennial with graceful spreading with age. Cream colored power-puff ball flowers;; brown fruit pods. REMOVE basal suckers in Spring.</p>
	<p>Pineapple Guava (Feijoa Sellowiana) Size: 15x12' Sun: Full sun to partial shade; does not like afternoon sun in AZ. Water: Little water, except during drought/dry spells. Drought/Heat: Tolerant.</p>
	<p>Texas Ebony (Ebenopsis ebano) or Mexican (Havardia mexicana) Ebany Size: 20x20' Sun: Full to filtered shade Water: Low except first year Notes: Mexican Ebony is taller than the Texas variety. Mexican Ebony is deciduous while Texas Ebony is semi-deciduous. Slow growth. Full sun to filtered shade. Thorns.</p>
	<p>Texas Mountain Laurel "Mescal Bean" (Sophora secundiflora) Size: 15x10' Sun: Full sun to partial sun Water: Low water after first year Drought/Heat: Tolerant Notes: Bean pods</p>

	<p>Chinese "Evergreen Elm" (Ulmus parvifolia) Size: 35x35' Sun: Full Water: Deep infrequent after first year Care: Prune lower branches and move excess weight on branches as it grows Drought/Heat: Tolerant</p>

	<p>Desert Museum Palo Verde (Cercidium hybrid) Size: 30x40' Sun: Full sun Water: Little to moderate water. Care: Prune to enhance form; remove crossing branches. Drought/Heat: Tolerant Notes: Over watering creates a weak root system and top-heavy tree. Plant deep to avoid cracking concrete AND 20' from buildings and other large trees</p>
	<p>Jacaranda (Jacaranda Mimosifolia) Size: 45x30' Sun: Full to partial Water: Medium; water frequently when temp >94F Care: In AZ prune to single trunk to reduce heat exposure. Drought/Heat: Tolerant Notes: Messy for several weeks each year while blooming</p>
	<p>Afghan Pine "Desert Pine or Mondell Pine (Pinus eldarica) Size: 40x15-20' Sun: Full sun Water: Low to moderate watering. Care: Annual feeding; trim lower branches Drought/Heat: Tolerant Notes: Must be planted in sandy, good drainage soil to avoid disease.</p>
	<p>Live Oak (Uercus virginiana) Size: 40x100' Sun: Full Water: Soak daily for 2wks, then every three days for remainder of Summer. Move drip heads further and further away from trunk to force root growth. Care: Prune limbs to distribute weight Drought/Heat: Tolerant of desert heat and cold. Notes: "Southern" variety can thrive in desert with lawn-watering schedule. Concrete and Pavement must be at least 20' from trunk. Deep tap root with shallow lateral roots 4-7 times size of crown.</p>
