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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

WATERFORD HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION

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The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Nonprofit corporation pursuant to the Nonprofit Corporation Act of the State of Arizona, Sections 10-1001, through 10-1127, inclusive, of the Arizona Revised Statutes, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this Arizona nonprofit corporation shall be WATERFORD HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION (the "Association"). The duration of the Association shall be Perpetual.

ARTICLE 11

The incorporators of the Association are Burgess J. William Raby and William L. Raby, 2164 E. Broadway Road, Suite 230, Tempe, A:120na 85282.

ARTICLE III

The principal offices of the Association are located at 2164 E Frondway Road, Suite 300, Tempe, Arizona 85282.

ARTICLE IV

The name and address of the initial Statutory Agent of the Association is BJWR Corporate Services, Inc., 2164 E. Broadway Ruad, Suite 230, Tempe, Arizona 85282.

ARTIGLE V

The purpose for which the Association is organized is to act is a tax-exempt homeowners' association in accordance with Section 52% of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or if the Corporation so elects, pursuant to Section 501(c) (4) of the Internal Code of 1986, as amended, and under the laws of the State of Aritona, and as such shall serve as a homeowner's association for the owners of lots and homes under the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Dave Brown V Homeowners' Association ("Declaration"), recorded in the office of the County Seconder of Maricopa County, Arizona.

The Association coes not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the Hembers thereof. In furtherance of, and in order to accomplish the general purposes of the Association, the Association may transact any and all lawful business for which nonprofit corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of

Arizona, as they may be amended from time to time. The apendical purpose for which the Association is formed is to provide for the maintenance, preservation and architectural control of the harmand lots in that part of the subdivision known as Dave Brown Davids according to the Plat of record in the office of the Mariana County Recorder, as more particularly described in the Declaration and to which additional property may be annexed, and if it was under the control of the Association, all of which property by this reference, is incorporated herein.

ARTICLE VI

The Association shall have all of those powers provided by law, including those set forth in the Arizona Revised Statutes. We they may be amended from time to time, and all those sometimes and convenient to effect the Association's purpose as last forth above, including but not limited to the power to exercise and of the rights and privileges and perform all duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in the Declaration, as the same be amended from time to time. In particular, the Association is formed to promote the health, safety and welfare of the resident within the property covered by the Declaration, and addition the Association, and for this purpose to:

- (a) Exercise all of the powers and privileges, and perform all of the duties and obligation of the Association as for in the Declaration as the same may be amended from the time as provided therein and, which, by this reference into the corporated herein;
- (b) Fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by any level, means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; to pay all expenses in connection therewith, and office and other expenses incidental to the conduct of hysical the Association, including all licenses, taxes and government charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association.
- (c) Acquire (by gift, purchase, or otherwise) hold, improve, build upon, operate, maintain, convey, sell, least transfer, dedicate for public use or otherwise dispose of sell personal property in connection with the affairs of Association, if otherwise provided in the Declaration:
- (d) Borrow money, and with the consent of 2/3 of many class of members, mortgage, pledge, or hypothecate and all of the property of the Association as security for borrowed money or incurred, if allowable under the Declaration;
- (e) Participate in mergers and consolidations with items nonprofit corporations erganized for the same purposes or assessed additional property and/or common area, provided that any merger, consolidation or annexation shall have the consent of a of each class of the members and the Federal Housing Administration

and/or the Veteran's Administration, as otherwise provided in the Declaration.

ARTICLE VII

Every person or entity who is a record owner of any lot of home in Waterford Homeowners' Association shall be a member of the Association, subject to and in accordance with the Declaration. The foregoing is not intended to include persons or entities the hold an interest merely as security for the performance of the obligation, either legal or equitable. The Association shall have no shareholders other than its Members, and no capital stock shall be authorised or issued.

ARTICLE VIII

The Association shall have two (2) classes of voting membership, namely Class A and Class B, as provided below:

Class A - Class A Members shall be all Owners, with the exception of Declarant (as such term is defined in the Declaration). Each Class A Member shall be entitled to can (as yote for each lot or home owned. When more than one (1) paraged holds interest in any lot or home, all such persons shall be exercised such persons among themselves determine, but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to any such lot or home. It is owner(s) cast(s) a vote representing a certain lot or home, it is thereafter be conclusively presumed for all purposes that see owner(s) was (were) acting with the authority and consent of see other owner(s) of the same lot or home.

Class B - The Class B Member shall, at the incention of the Association, be Declarant, who shall be entitled to them it wotes for each lot or home owned. Each Class B membershape representing lots owned by Declarant shall cease and be converted to Class A membership on the happening of either of the following events, whichever occurs earlier:

- (a) When the total votes outstanding in the class membership equals or exceeds the total votes outstanding in the Class B membership; or
 - (b) On January 1, 2004; or
- (c) Five years after Declarant has ceased offering Lots or Residences for sale in the ordinary course of business.

If any lender to whom Declarant has or may hereafter estimated as security, all or substantially all of its rights under the Declaration succeeds to the interests of such Declarant by virtue of said assignment, the Class B memberships shall not be terminated.

The first annual meeting of the Members of the Association shall be held within thirty (30) days after the conversion of exithe Class B memberships to Class A memberships, as above provided or at such earlier time as the Board of Directors shall designed. The dates of subsequent annual meetings shall be as provided in the Bylaws of the Association. Until such time as the first meeting is required to be held, as herein provided, the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes Section 10-1013(B) are hereby waited.

ARTICLE IX

The affairs of the Association shall be conducted by a special of not less than three (3), nor more than twenty-fire directors and such officers as the directors may elect and appears the number of directors may be changed by amendment of the Spian of the Association.

As long as there is a Class B Member, each of the following actions shall require the prior approval of the Federal Resident Administration or the Veterans Administration: annexation in

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additional properties, mergers and consolidations, mortgaging or encumbering of any common areas and or dedication of any common areas (if such common area come within the control of the Association), or dissolution and amendment of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE XVI

The fiscal year of the Association shall be the calendar year from January 1 through December 31 of each year.
