Asphalt Concerns

At the July Board Meeting, a representative from Cactus Asphalt addressed concerns regarding the condition of our roads and quality of workmanship, particularly on the East side. Key points from the discussion with residents and Board members:

- The underlying slurry and road sealant materials become malleable after installation, coupled with high temperatures, stress from turning car tires and such will cause divots and other damage. This is just a fact of life living in Arizona with asphalt roads.
- Cactus will repair damaged areas under warranty, but cannot do so until the Fall, when temperatures are more temperate.
- Better notice of the work schedule, signage around the work areas, and cure times will be provided.
