Congratulations New Board Members!

With 74 votes received and over 55% of the membership voting, **Gretchen Carlson** and **Eva Kuo** were elected to the Board. They were each elected to serve a two-year term, expiring in 2023.

The Annual Meeting was a good opportunity to highlight the prior year's accomplishments as well as look ahead to upcoming projects.

Last year was an exceptionally busy year for the Association as the Board delivered on initiatives to improve customer service and increase control over operating expenses:

Weed Control Program

The Association carries out a bi-annual program to control weeds in Ranch common areas and the Pathway along the western border of the subdivision. The goal is to control noxious weeds, provide safe and healthy turf, and protect trees and shrubs.

Control measures include mechanical trimming, removal by hand, and application of pre-emergents and herbicides.

This year's first application was applied on **Monday, January 11, 2021**, and included granite and turf areas. The second application is scheduled for **Wednesday, July 7th**.

Timing of Treatment: Herbicide application will start in early morning, or mid-day when the winds are generally light. Exact times and dates of treatment will depend on weather condition and wind direction.

June / July Landscaping Calendar

Palm Trimming: The best time of year to trim Mexican fan palms is after June 15, to be sure to get all the seed pods in a single trimming. You can also trim Queen palms anytime after June 1, but expect some seed pods to continue to emerge through the fall. <u>Palm trimming reminder letters will be sent</u> <u>after July 15th</u> to Members with palm trees that still need to be trimmed.

Tree Trimming: Monsoon winds are right around the corner. To reduce the risk of tree or branch failure, schedule pruning of large trees including mesquites, sumacs, eucalyptus and other vigorous desert tree varieties.
