List of Recommended Trees for Common Areas

- 1. <u>Bay Laurel or Sweet Bay (Laurus nobilis)</u> 20-40 ft tall with 15-30 ft spread.
- 2. Cascalote (Tara cacalaco) 15-20 ft tall with equal spread (Note: "Smoothie" is thornless)
- 3. Chaste tree (Vitex agnus-castus) 15-20 ft tall with equal
- 4. Chilean Mesquite (Prosopis sp.) 30 ft tall with equal spread (Note: look for thornless selections)
- 5. Desert Willow (Chilopsis linearis) 15-35 ft tall (more water = taller) with equal or greater spread
- 6. Evergreen Elm (Ulmus parvifolia) 35 ft tall with equal spread
- 7. Fruitless Olive (Olea europaea 'Swan Hill') 25-30 ft tall with equal spread
- 8. Ironwood (Olneya tesota) 25 ft tall with equal spread
- 9. Live Oak (Quercus virginiana) 25-40 ft tall with equal spread
- 10. Mastic (Pistacia lentiscus) 25 ft tall with equal spread
- 11. Mulga (Acacia Aneura) 20-25 ft tall with equal or lesser spread
- 12. Ocotillo (Fouquieria splendens) can reach heights of up to 20 feet.
- 13. Palo Blanco (Acacia willardiana) 20 ft tall with equal or less spread
- 14. Purple leaf plum (Prunus cearasifer) 20-25 ft tall with less than equal spread
- 15. Red Push Pistache (Pistacia x 'Red Push') 30-40 ft tall with equal spread
- 16. Snail seed (Cocculus laurifolius) 10-25 ft with equal spread
- 17. <u>Texas Mountain Laurel (Sophora secundiflora)</u> 10-25 ft tall with equal spread
- 18. Texas Olive (Cordia boissieri) 15-20 ft with equal spread
- 19. Twisted acacia (Acacia schaffneri) 20-25 ft tall with 25-30 ft spread
- 20. Yellow Bell or Yellow Oleander (Cascabela thevetia) 10-15ft tall with equal spread
