COMMUNITY INFO & HOA NEWS:

•HOA payments will be increased by \$5 per month starting January 2022. The new payment should be made for \$100. If you have auto pay set-up you will need to make this adjustment prior to the due date.

• Due to the increase in cost and availability of grass seed this year the BOD decided to not over-seed. This will not only save the cost of seed but also save in the water bill.

• Please be aware that the light fixtures in the common areas will be replaced soon so you will see construction in the community for approximately 7-10 days. Ramsey Electric will be removing a series of lights and replacing them in sections in order to limit the disturbance. You will see them soon --unless they already started by the time this newsletter is out.

•We will be replacing the granite along 32nd St. next year, so

expect to see this construction in the early months of 2022.
