- 1. Nest Thermostat: These smart thermostats learn what temperature you like, and at what times, and then optimize your heating/cooling for the greatest comfort and energy savings.
- 2. Smart light bulbs: Available in a variety of brands to be paired with devices like Alexa or Google Home, lightbulbs can be controlled using our voice or scheduled to automatically turn on/off.
- 3. Ring Doorbell: Part doorbell, part security system, these gadgets connect to an app on your phone so you can see when (and who) approaches your front door.

LEARN ABOUT WHAT IT MEANS TO LIVE IN AN HOA: Our Side Yards are what we call Easement Areas; both homeowners have access to them. Our community was designed with side yard/easement areas that our neighbor needs access to. (For example, when you paint your home, you must have access to your neighbor's side yard.) The easement owner is asked to give the lot owner a heads up that they are entering the side yard to take care of the property located in the easement area. The lot owner can't deny access to the easement owner when the easement owner gives notice.
