Policy for homeowners/Agents speaking at Board meetings: Adopted at July 28, 2005 Board meeting.

- a) Members only speak to the chair,
- b) When recognized by the Board chairman, the member shall state their name and address or lot number.
- c) In discussing controversial matters where a large part of the membership is present, the Board shall decide the most appropriate time on the agenda to discuss the topic. Each member/agent is limited to three (3) minutes each time the person is recognized by the chairman. This will be repeated for each controversial matter. The discussion for each controversial matter shall be completed within 45 minutes.

(ONLY issues will be debated. Personal attacks will not be tolerated.)

d) At the start of a board meeting and in circumstances where there are only one (1) to a few homeowners/agents present that are not part of the meeting agenda, homeowners in attendance shall be allowed the lesser of; (a) five (5) minutes each or, (b) 25 minutes divided by the number of homeowners present. During their allotted time, each homeowner shall be allowed to address the Board on topics not on the agenda.

During the meeting and after a topic on the agenda is discussed by the Board, three (3) homeowner/agent present will be given the opportunity to speak to the Board for three (3) minutes each on that particular topic before a decision is made by the Board. Once a decision is reached, the Board will then move on to the next topic on the agenda and the process will repeat once more.

e) Any of these rules may be amended or waived by the Board as approved.
